In general, as a puppy or kitten, vaccinations will be boosted every 3 or 4 weeks until the pet is 16 weeks of age. Specific vaccinations, like the Leptospirosis, Bordetella or Feline Leukemia vaccine, are dependent on lifestyle. Ask the veterinarian about lifestyle vaccines and whether your pet may or may not need them. The rabies vaccination, no matter the species of the pet, is the only vaccination required by law.
